

Starfire Golf Club COVID-19 Update

Starfire Golf Club guests will be required to wear a mask in all public areas of the Golf Club, the Golf Shop, Clubhouse, & Grille. Guests may remove once on course if they prefer.

WE WILL NO LONGER BE ALLOWING SINGLE RIDER carts. This policy will be in effect through the end of 2020 or until further notice. If you have any questions or concerns about this, please contact the golf shop prior to your arrival for play.

As we continue to remain open for play in these unprecedented times, the safety and well-being of our staff and our guests continues to be our top priority. While our staff is working diligently to ensure the safest possible environment, we ask that you join us in helping to keep everyone safe through the coming weeks and months if you chose to join us for golf or dining. However, if you have any concerns or symptoms of Covid-19 please remember, the safest option is always to stay home. Please be respectful of others.

We will continue to do the following to provide the safest and cleanest environment we can for all guests:

- All carts are cleaned/sanitized before and after each use.
- Sand bottles, water coolers, and rakes have been removed from the course and carts.
- High traffic areas and touch points are being cleaned/sanitized in our Golf Shop and Clubhouse areas multiple times per day.
- Bag Drop – staff will be unloading and loading bags from vehicles only upon request. We will have sanitized carts staged at the bag drop for guests to load their own bags if they prefer.
- All staff will be wearing a mask for the added safety of the guests.

What we ask of our guests to assist in providing a safe environment:

- Do not remove the flagstick when putting on the green
- Use your foot or clubs to smooth out the areas in the bunker you have played from since we have removed all rakes for the time being
- All water coolers have been removed from the golf course. You can use our grab and go or bar service in the restaurant to purchase bottled water or our player assistant staff will be making rounds on the course with water for you
- Wash your hands often with soap and hot water, if not available please use hand sanitizer
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands
- Cover your mouth and nose with tissue or sleeve when you sneeze or cough
- Practice social distancing
- Be safe and respectful of others during these unprecedented times as everyone has their own current beliefs and concerns about our environment in today's trying times.
